NOISE MAKERS: The LOC reserves the right to substitute devices that simulate the sound of a shotgun.

NOTE: 1) Rotation: A System of Rotation will be implemented for All-age stakes after the first series (See CKC Rule Book section 6.6.1.c for details).

2) Judges can disqualify any dog which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tried.

3) Dogs will run in order unless excused by the marshal for that stake.

4) Bitches and dogs will run in the order drawn.

Discipline Section 21.7 Trial Rules & Regulations for Retriever Trials (2008 edition) states: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

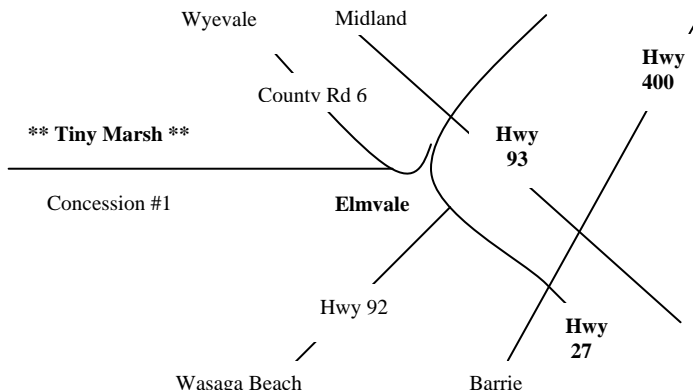
