### Junior Puppy Dog

1st Blackoaks Russel Me Up 7 month balanced baby, sweet head, good eye, good body proportions, well set tail, adequate bone, neat feet, correct coat, moved freely.

2nd Maktawae Tucker at Dragonsong Not quite as together, promising head, good eye, well boned, good body and tail set, correct turn of stifle, moved o.k.

3rd Madabouts Westin Peace 7 months, not as balanced yet, head still has plenty of work, bigger pup and will take longer, but he is well made and moves very freely

### Senior Puppy Dog

1st Chablais Basil Well grown pale yellow, pleasant head and eye, clean neck, well developed body needs no more weight, good bone, correct angles, good topline and moved well.

2nd Paradocs Finnegan Really liked him, just too out of coat to take the class, pleasant well shaped head and eye, good conformation, well set tail, good bone and feet, showed and moved well

3rd Gaff's Pied Piper Liked him but he can stand close in front, short coupled well bodied, needs no more weight, pleasing head, in top puppy coat, moved ok.

4th Swentina Chablais Sirius Plenty of head, good expression, not as together yet, reasonable angles, and movement a little loose.

### 12-15 months Dog

1st Shalane Rolling Stone Very hot, eventually assessed head and teeth, nice type, good body and angles, losing coat, moved ok.

2nd Cawarra's Macintosh Different type yellow, needs to mature in body, adequate bone, good angles, moved well.

### 15-18 months Dog

1st Kriscoland's Breaking Waves Lovely headed black, good expression, clean neck, good front, good body, topline and tailset, well boned, coat ok, moved well.

2nd Adventure's Pull the Trigger Stronger head, eye ok, good front and body, tends to fall away at rear when standing, moved ok.

3rd Chablais Chocolatier Preferred heads and eyes on 1&2, well bodied choc. A little upright in front, good quarters and tail, good coat and moved freely.

### **Canadian Bred Dog**

1st Kerrybrook's Marita's Brodie Choc. Well made, reasonable head, eye colour ok, good body, in good coat, good hindquarters and moved well.

2nd Skazka's Rimfire Rifle Well made black, good head, in reasonable coat, still needs to body up, movement not as positive as 1.

3rd Hunterleigh's Paradocs Giorgio Gentle yellow, could have more stop in head, out of coat, well made, good quarters, moved freely.

4th Chablais Justin Pleasant head, too much weight affecting movement, reasonable angles.

### **Bred By Exhibitor**

1st Paradocs Tabatha's Caillou My find of the day, mature lovely black with good head and gentle expression, good front, ribs, deep body, powerful hindquarters, correct tail, in full coat and moved easily. Winners Dog and BOS.

2nd Citadel Hook Line and Sinker Again very nice black, well made just not the hindquarters of 1, good body and moved well.

3rd Chestnuts Charlie Brown Strong headed choc., plenty of bone, deep body, reasonable hindquarters, moved ok.

4th Chablais Favel Nice choc. But unfortunately not quite sound in front, well bodied, and good angles.

### **Open Dog Class (Black)**

1st Tabatha's Adventure Score Just my type, balanced head, good eye, not in coat but texture ok and just enough, strong neck, deep body, good flow from neck to tail, correct turn of stifle and hock, well set tail and moved ok.

2nd Jaunenoir's Etoile Eveque Masculine head, stronger than 1, has length of body but has the height to balance, good angles and moves freely, in good coat.

3rd Chestnuts Country Joe Lovely head and eye, slightly smaller in stature, good overall conformation, good bone, well set tail and moved ok, just died a bit in the heat.

4th Paradocs Delians Scrubbing In Stronger headed, good eye, powerful neck, deep bodied, good angles, good tail and moved well.

### **Open Dog Class (Yellow)**

1st Broadway's On The Town Pleasing head, eye and expression, good neck and reasonable front, deep mature body, good length, ample bone, tailset ok, good hindquarters and moved very well. RWD

2nd Summersun Dashing Hugo Boss Stronger head and would prefer a slightly darker eye, reasonable front, good body, well set tail, reasonable hindquarters and moved well.

### **Veteran Dog Class**

1st Ch. Nyroca's Instant Message 11 year old in excellent order, masculine gentle head and expression, well made, good ribs and body, excellent bone and feet, well set tail, in good coat and still moves extremely well. JAM

2nd Ch. Corhampton Asklar Mister Right Another lovely male 8 years old, masculine head, good eye, good front and body, well set tail, good angles and moved out well.

3rd Ch. Castlegar Elliott 7 year old black, not quite as moulded in head, but good head and expression, clean front, good ribs and body, well angulated hind, not quite the quarters of 1 & 2 or tail, moved freely.

4th Ch. Otch. Pinebank Phantom of the Night 8 years old, very fit, again not quite the moulding in head, reasonable front, good ribs and body, well set tail, coat ok, moved well as one would expect.

### **Junior Puppy Bitch (a good class, close decisions.)**

1st Marjo's Peggy Sue Very pretty, lovely head and eye, excellent pigment, good body, good bone, well angulated throughout, well developed hindquarters and moved well. BPIS

2nd Marjo's Popsicle Citadel Litter sister to 1, similar remarks, another very nice puppy, pleasing head, good body and coat, good bone, good hindquarters and tail, moved well.

3rd Castlegar Calypso Very much the baby, but is well put together, sweet head, good expression, good body and hindquarters, moved positively.

4th Bluesouth's Destiny Abroad A little more mature in body, promising head still to soften, excels in hindquarters, adequate bone, moved well

### **Senior Puppy Bitch**

1st Oulsmi Just For You Lovely balanced head, good eye and expression, clean neck, good front, excellent body and hindquarters, adequate bone, good feet, moved well but could fly her tail on the move.

2nd Paradocs Beverley Slightly stronger in head, good eye and expression, good front, deep body, a little longer cast than 1, excellent hindquarters, good tail, moved well.

3rd Ginander Taylor Made for Fargo Pretty bitch good pigment, not quite as good in front, good body and hindquarters, good tail, moved freely.

4th Asklar's Lucky Ticket Not as mature, pretty head, excellent pigment, reasonable angles, needs a bit more confidence.

### **12-15 Month Bitch**

1st Nyroca's Acadence Gorgeous head and eye, clean neck and good front, good body, well turned stifle and hock, adequate bone, not in full coat, moved and showed well.

2nd Jaunenoir's Right On Da Money Pretty head, good angles, good depth of body, changing coat, but it was correct texture, good hindquarters, moved freely.

3rd Beadog Poison Ivy Promising head, good eye, clean neck, good body, still immature, good topline and tail, moved well.

4th Gorsebrook Queen of May Pretty yellow, nice eye shape, not as mature, but reasonable angles, good coat and moved well.

### **15-18 Month Bitch**

1st Loudon's Rose of Texas Pleasing head and eye, good overall conformation, good body and ribs, good hindquarters, in excellent coat, moved ok.

2nd Gaff's Gypsy Girl Pleasant head and eye, good front and body, longer cast than 1, excellent front extension on the move, losing coat.

### **Canadian Bred Bitch**

1st Hunterleigh's Paradocs Gwen Pretty yellow, could have a little more length of muzzle, strong neck, good front and body, good hindquarters, moved ok.

2nd Chablais Chocolatine Pleasant head, expression still to soften, good neck and front, good body, needs no more weight, good hindquarters, reasonable tail, moved ok.

3rd Oaksill Anticipation Lovely head, good angles, but needs to deepen and have more depth of coat, has a length of leg and will be slower to mature, moved well.

### **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch**

1st Chablais Violette Very nice bitch in full coat, mature balanced head, good eye, deep through the body, excels in hindquarters, good tail and moved well.

2nd Paradocs Stella De Oro Pretty yellow, balanced head, good conformation, excellent body, very showy, just lost out on coat.

3rd Citadel Just Peachy Pretty black, balanced head with good eye, good overall conformation and body, in coat and moved ok.

4th Bralex's Hazardoustoyourhealth Attractive choc. But out of coat, nice type, good conformation and moved well.

### **Open Bitch Black**

1st Adventurer's Ferget Me Not Liked head and eye, short coupled compact bitch, good angles, good ribs and body, well set tail; good bone and feet, in good coat and moved freely.

2nd Lobuff Woodloch Splash n Round Slightly longer cast, could just lose topline, well balanced head, eye dark enough, good angles, hindquarters and well set tail, moved ok, in good coat

3rd Broadway's Babe at Wayfield Lovely head and eye, a little long cast, but a good moving girl, in reasonable coat.

4th Marjo's Dixie Cup Pleasant head, eye ok, good neck and deep through ribs and body, not the hindquarters of 1 or 2, well set tail, moved ok

### **Open Bitch Yellow**

1st Marjo's Murphy Brown Kind headed, good eye shape, balanced, clean neck which flows into level topline and tail, deep ribs good body, good bone, neat feet, good quarters and moved well. Winners Bitch and BISS

2nd Tabatha's Hampton Cinco De Mayo Lovely head , similar remarks to 1, but just not the quarters or quite the coat of 1, very nice bitch.

3rd Lobuff Hollyridge Kiskadee Pleasant head, slightly longer cast, well made, losing more coat and just flicked feet in on front movement.

4th Wishingstar's Crystal Light Pale yellow, balanced head, good eye, clean neck, adequate bone, good ribs, moved ok.

### **Open Chocolate Bitch**

1st Snowden Hill Camelot KitKat Balanced head, eye colour ok, could be darker, strong neck, reasonable front, good bone and feet, deep body, good tail and moved ok. RWB

2nd Beachbrooks Day Dream Believer Pleasant head, eye ok, not as good in front, good ribs and body and hindquarters, moved well.

3rd Willcare Edlyn Tx T at Mdstn Head balanced, eye colour ok, good body and bone, can lose topline, good quarters and tail, moved well.

4th Lubberline Castlegar Chocolate Bunny Pleasing head, eye could be darker, well made but does not help herself standing, moved well

### **Veteran Bitch**

1st Tabatha's Confetti Lovely yellow, pretty head good eye, good flow of neck into shoulders and good front, deep body, good tail, never stopped wagging, good hind angles, moves well.

2nd Ch. Kriscoland's Ophelia Classic black, shorter in neck, strong well bodied, excellent tail, good quarters, moved well.

3rd Ch. Devonsleigh's Miss Independent Lighter yellow, pretty head, good overall conformation, moved well.

4th Chepenco Flight of The Raven Black balanced head with length of muzzle, good reach of neck, good hindquarters, very fit and needs to be gone over to appreciate, moves freely.
